

## Term 1 Newsletter- Primary 2A

Welcome to Primary 2! We have had a great start to the term and are working very hard. Below is a further update on what we will be learning this term.

### Numeracy

We will be learning about number and number processes to 20 and 100. We will be comparing and ordering numbers, finding the number before/after, learning about odd and even numbers and place value.

We will also be focusing on 2D and 3D shape this term, where we will be learning to describe these shapes in further detail- for example, how many sides/ corners/ faces do they have?

### Literacy

In phonics this term, we will be consolidating our knowledge of digraphs sh, ch, th, ng, ph, wh, ee, oo, oa and ai which we first looked at in P1.

We will be learning 3 new tricky words per week this term.

In reading, we will concentrate on using our phonics and tricky word knowledge to help us break down unfamiliar words. For comprehension, we will be focusing on finding the main events/ideas in our reading book and sequencing these.

### Topic

Our topic for this term is Toys. We will be comparing toys we play with today to toys from the past as well as researching different ways we can find out about the past. We will also be learning about forces, electricity and materials within the context of Toys.

### P.E

P.E days will be Wednesday with Mrs Burnell and Thursday with myself. Full P.E kit is required on both days.

### Homework

All homework will be issued on a Monday and due for Thursday. This consists of two short literacy tasks in homework jotters and one maths game on Education City, as detailed in letters sent out last week.
