#### Parental Engagement

This appointment will also allow you to have a discussion with your child's keyworker about any concerns you may have.

Please remember, we at Meethill pride ourselves on our 'Open Door Policy' welcoming parents/carers into the setting at any time to discuss concerns or share feedback they may have. Someone will always be happy to speak to you!

We will also be welcoming families to join us during our Stay & Play sessions – these sessions allow you to come and play with your child in the Nursery setting without the interruptions or distractions of everyday life! These sessions will run on a Monday & Friday during your child's normal session. If this is something you or a member of your family would be interested in, please speak to a member of staff who can get you booked in.

Do you have any talents or perhaps a career you would like to share with us? We are looking for family members to talk to us about the wider world and people who help us. If you have something you would be able to share, please talk to a member of staff!

#### Clothing
